The sooner society transitions to fully autonomous vehicles, the better. As a victim of a careless driver myself, I consider all efforts to get to Level 4 and 5 autonomous vehicles to be worthy and urgent.

In 2010, there were an estimated 5,419,000 crashes, 30,296 with fatalities, killing 32,999, and injuring 2,239,000. About 2,000 children under 16 die every year in traffic collisions. Records indicate that there were 3,613,732 motor vehicle fatalities in the United States from 1899 to 2013.

Such barbarity need to stop. I call on all regulatory agencies to assist in making this transition to fully autonomous vehicles as expeditious and as painless as possible.
