Chronology:

On May 3, 2016, the Agency issued an Amendment to the November 3, 2015 Consent Order in EA15-001. The Agency has concluded that the rate at which propellant degradation may occur in non-desiccated frontal airbag inflators varies based upon geographic factors of environmental heat and humidity. In light of the Agency's findings, NHTSA has concluded that at some point in the future all non-desiccated frontal Takata PSAN inflators will reach a threshold level of degradation that could result in the inflator becoming unreasonably dangerous.

By December 31, 2018, Takata is expected to issue Defect Information Reports in accordance with the terms specified in the May 3, 2016 Amendment to the November 3, 2015 Consent Order in EA15-001. Takata is not aware of any test ruptures in ballistic testing or confirmed field incidents of the subject non-desiccated ammonium nitrate inflators other than those already under recall.

In anticipation of Takata's filing, on December 17, 2018, Ford's Field Review Committee reviewed the concern and approved a field action.
