Units in production were re-worked and the design discontinued. 4/26-2019 during an internal audit a unit was discovered in production with the suspect design, a stop ship was put in place to establish a clean point for production and the design has now been removed from our engineering system. 5/3/2019 in review of all the data compiled, Autocar made the determination to perform a safety recall due to a non-compliance in brake release time.
