Camera monitors in place of traditional outside mirrors will have a potential to create a distraction for a driver as to the road ahead. I could also see a driver developing a cognitive disconnect as to what is actually happening outside of the vehicle. It would seem to me looking exclusively at a screen to check the surroundings of a vehicle would be similar to watching it on TV or some other electronic screen. Whats more, A screen in front of a driver, in place of traditional outside mirrors on each side would take away the Smith System Key, Keep Your Eyes Moving.

Some sort of camera monitor system along with the traditional mirrors to complement each other may be a much safer set up. Providing that the monitors for the cameras are not placed in the direct line of sight of a driver.
