

## Comment from Thomas Dubois

Rear motor vehicle visibility could be improved with cameras provided: 1. Cameras are mounted far enough forward on the vehicle to gain the widest perspective rearward. 2. Video monitors (screens) are positioned directly in front of the driver so that they can be seen without having to turn to look at them. Incorporating blind-spot-monitoring on the screens as a secondary alert could maximize the effectiveness of this system. 3. Camera lenses are kept clean.
