Comment from Mark Dyer

As a seasoned vehicle driver, and one in possession of a vehicle with a "backup assist" rear view camera, I submit that replacing a physical outside mirror with a camera assisted rear view display is unsafe for the following reasons

- > The camera lens can become covered with debris and will require the vehicle operator to stop and clean the camera lens to restore visibility
- > Malfuncion of a camera lens cannot be readily determined by law enforcement whereas broken, or missing, outside mirrors are easily observed
- > The electronics that operate the camera can malfunction at any time, without notice to the driver whereas a physical outside mirror cannot malfunction as it has no electronics making it function.
