It has been proposed that cameras take the place of rear view mirrors in cars. This is NOT ACCEPTABLE. If car manufacturers want to use cameras IN ADDITION to rear view mirrors, that would be a good thing. But cameras are prone to failure, even if it rarely happens. You don't want drivers suddenly blinded totally by rear view camera failure. So I would oppose the current proposal. Please consider requiring or encouraging BOTH, but it simply is not safe for the car to have no mirrors, since cameras can and occasionally do fail. Another consideration is that drivers won't necessarily visually interpret what a camera is seeing, since sizes of images and things like that can change. A driver learns to trust that a mirror will always display in the same way at all times.
