We far-sighted seniors will have difficulty focusing on the screen of a rear view camera.

When viewing the simple and reliable rear view mirror, our eyes focus on the distant object reflected in the mirror.

When attempting to view a camera screen, our eyes must focus on the screen surface that is merely inches from our eyes. To use conventional bi- or tri-focals, the screen would need to be located in the center of the steering wheel.
