

Comment from Tom Scarpello

Overall, the regulations are well written and consistent with the legislation. Specific comments:

- 1.) Requirement to resemble the replicated vehicle: OK to mandate height, width, and length of the body (not overall vehicle), but with the flexibility to increase 10% in any dimension to accommodate for product changes necessary to improve safety.
- 2.) Reporting requirements are OK as written
- 3.) Label placement and content: Driver's side door jamb. Label should state that vehicle is exempt from specific FMVSS and direct the reader to a website for complete information. Not practical to list each regulation for which the vehicle is exempt on the label
- 4.) Intellectual property rights: OK as written. Manufacturer should demonstrate it has acquired the rights.
- 5.) VIN: OK as written. Manufacturer should encode the make, model, and year of the original replicated vehicle in the VIN
