

Comment from Ride N Remind System / (The Backseat Minder)

The Ride N Remind System - previously known as The Backseat Minder - is an aftermarket system that was developed in 2009 to prevent hot car deaths.

The system was designed to be devoid of the flaws inherent in systems that rely on batteries or wireless technology.

The principle of the system is that if the rear door was opened and closed shortly prior to turning on the ignition, there most likely is an occupant or item that the driver needs to be reminded about at the end of the ride.

More than just a reminder though, The Ride N Remind System requires the driver to check the back seat, by reopening the rear door and pushing a button inside. If they fail to do so within a predetermined amount of time, the horn will sound a loud noticeable SOS signal. This feature adds a dimension of accountability that every parent can appreciate - even when not needed.

The system has many useful optional features. (i.e. whether to allow canceling the reminder before the key is turned off, horn delay etc.)
