## ADAPTIVE STEERING

The Ford steering system adapts to driving conditions to make steering easier at low speeds and more robust at high speeds. ## QUIET RIDE

Acoustic-laminate windshield glass is standard for every model. Edge Sport is equipped with active noise control technology designed to refine the sound of the 2.7-liter EcoBoost. Sport and Titanium models incorporate acoustic glass on driver and passenger doors.
