Appendix E (“Air Quality Modeling and Health Impacts Assessment”) of the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration’s (NHTSA) Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) summarizes the application of air quality modeling tools to assess the potential impacts on air quality and the related health effects of the Safer Affordable Fuel-Efficient (SAFE) Vehicles Rule. This appendix is based on the results of complex photochemical air quality modeling. The output files associated with that modeling amount to several terabytes of data that cannot readily be made available for download. As a result, those files are not included in the public docket on <https://www.regulations.gov> for this action or on NHTSA’s website.
