Though the message that pops up on the screen when the car is in reverse took some portion off the full screen, but it shows an important alert or message to the driver. Mercedes-Benz has confirmed that, the text box takes only 10 percent of the screen. With that, the remaining 90 percent is enough to show all the surroundings and it also meets the minimum requirement of 150-mm wide. This text box is designed to fill the gap for those who like reading.

I don't think this is a problem with regards to vehicle safety. I think this upgrade to the previous CLA 250 is nice and I like it. I suggest Mercedes-Benz should be allowed to do the good work they've been doing over the years, because this kind of upgrade meets the "customers" need.
