8/18/2020 Forest River's Manufacturing plant was auditing the installation of the new 3000W inverter and noticed that there was a 50 amp breaker on the side of the inverter which was not present in the prior used 2000W inverter. Plant began communicating with the vendor, questioning its function, and gathering information.

8/31/2020 The plant completed its investigation and determined that to continue using the 3000W inverter it would require changing the wiring to a 6 gauge wire, installing a 12V disconnect and (2) 50 amp breakers.

8/31/2020 The plant notified Office Corporate Compliance.

9/4/2020 Forest River's Corporate Recall Committee voted to recall.
