January 20, 2021 internal campaign and inspections on 485 trucks completed, three vehicles are identified which may have suspect wheels are in dealers hands. January 27, 2021 those three vehicles are located and inspected by dealers and suspect wheels are not found This information is provided to Howmet, vehicles had not been delivered to customers or entered in service. February 10, 2021 Howmet notifies Volvo of of their filing 21E-007 dated February 1, 2021. February 18, 2021 Volvo Group North America Regulatory Affairs submits 573 report. There are no vehicles in service affected by the recall. There have been no incidents, accidents or injuries reported involving these parts.
