On July 19, 2021, Shyft received notice of recall 21E-063 from Cummins along with an engine serial number list. On July 20, 2021 Shyft began cross referencing the engine serial numbers to vehicle identification numbers. On July 21, 2021, Shyft issued a stop ship on chassis still in it's possession and on July 22, 2021, Shyft determined that a defect related to motor vehicle safety could exist in the remaining chassis.

Description of Remedy :
