I highly support replacing side view mirrors with cameras. I'm 58-years-old and started to drive a Tesla with side view cameras in 2019. These days I simply don't use the side view mirrors anymore. These mirrors have become a redundant cost that increase the car's drag coefficient and manufacturing complexity.

The side cameras feed inside to my car's central screen. They are consistently aimed in the proper direction and provide a clearer picture than if I was to look at the side mirror or even turn my head around to look. Side cameras completely eliminate those elusive and dangerous blind spots!

Each time I turn on my right turn signal, I see a live color camera view on the right side of my car looking towards the rear. Ditto for the left turn signal.
