Appendix D (“Air Quality Modeling and Health Impacts Assessment”) of the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration’s (NHTSA) Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) for Model Year 2024-2026 Corporate Average Fuel Economy Standards summarizes the application of air quality modeling tools to assess the potential impacts of the standards on air quality and the related health effects. This appendix is based on the results of complex photochemical air quality modeling. The output files associated with that modeling amount to several terabytes of data that cannot readily be made available for download.
