On February 14, 2023, at the request of American Trucking Associations (ATA), the Office of Information and Regulatory Affairs (OIRA) had an Executive Order 12866 meeting with ATA representatives via teleconference regarding the Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, "Side underride guards on trailers and semitrailers," RIN:2127-AM54. U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) staff were also present at this teleconference meeting. ATA representatives discussed engineering and operational challenges associated with side underride guards on trailers and requested DOT to complete the necessary research on side underride guards mandated by the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law before proceeding to the proposal stage of the rulemaking.
