As of February 8, 2023, the current value of the Base Course Wear Rate (BCWR) for the Course Monitoring Tires (CMTs) is **6.9355** as per the Uniform Tire Quality Grading Standard (UTQGS) treadwear testing procedures; the agency will update the BCWR number every three months.¹
