In June 2024, a dealership submitted a claim on an Access unit stating there was a non-GFCI outlet installed within 6 feet of the sink. A complete compliance review was initiated on all WTOW models. It was found that 3 Voyage floorplans and 1 Minnie floorplan were impacted as well.

On August 9, 2024 the Product Safety Committee decided the issue presented an unreasonable risk to motor vehicle safety and was a violation of NFPA 70 551.41. The issue was corrected in production and all engineering prints were updated.

Winnebago is not aware of any customer complaints, accidents, injuries, or property damage because of this condition.
