July 11, 2024-July 29, 2024, Autocar personnel identified two units in production with the exhaust diffusers pointed toward the fuel tanks and began investigation. August 15, 2024-August 22, 2024, all in-house units were inspected, and a clean point established for production. August 22, 2024, all information was presented to Autocar's management team and Autocar decided to perform a voluntary safety recall for all potential units. We have no known cases, complaints or claims.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: Autocar will voluntarily initiate an owner notification and recall of all

affected vehicles. Autocar will distribute to owners of affected vehicles an Owner Notification Letter, which will describe the defect and provide instructions for scheduling the inspection/repair of the vehicle at no cost to the vehicle's owner. The owner letter will instruct vehicle owners who have paid to have this condition remedied prior to this campaign to seek reimbursement pursuant to Autocar's General Reimbursement Plan, on file

with the agency pursuant to 49 C.F.R. 573.6(c) (8) (i) and 49 C.F.R 573.13.
