Chronology:

In late September, Winnebago Product Safety became aware of a concern with the Lippert (Metallarte) door assembly windows with allegations of partial and/or full detachment of the window in transit. An investigation was subsequently opened. During the investigation, Winnebago identified 121 total claims from 2019 to mid-2023. It was also found that Lippert provided repair instructions regarding the process of re-adhering the window to the door assembly.

On October 25, 2024, the Product Safety Committee met and determined that a defect related to motor vehicle safety was present.

Winnebago is aware of 2 unconfirmed detachments in the field and 121 total claims of loose windows. Winnebago is not aware of any injuries or property damage associated with this issue.
