Description of the Defect: The subject vehicles are equipped with a wheelchair securement system to

meet ADA requirements. The system is design to have 2 attachment points to secure the front of the wheelchair and 2 to secure the rear. The subject vehicles may have been manufactured with only one attachment point at the front of

the wheelchair and 3 at the rear.

Description of the Safety Risk: With the wheelchair attachment belt in an incorrect position, the wheelchair

could move more than intended while the vehicle is in motion. A wheelchair

moving more than intended can lead to injury for the passenger.

Description of the Cause: Wheelchair securement point installed on wrong side of the flip-up seat.

safety-related defect.
