During this time the new assembly station at the supplier had wrong software control parameters. The correct control parameters in software were implemented after 2024-10-08 and all FSABs after this date have been produced with the new control parameters. This recall affects certain model year 2024 Polestar 2 vehicles.

Description of the Defect :	The clamps are not crimped properly on the driver side inner FSAB.
FMVSS 1 :	NR

Description of the Safety Risk :	As a result, in the event of a crash, the driver side inner FSAB may not deploy correctly, increasing the risk of injury.
Description of the Cause :	Missed crimping process for airbag during subassembly from supplier due to human error, that was not identified due to wrong software control parameters in assembly process.
Identification of Any Warning that can Occur :	There will be no customer warning or indications.

Extended Chronology of event:

2024-12-05 Polestar was notified by its supplier that they had found a potentially critical issue with the farside airbag (FSAB). The investigation was escalated through the Critical Concern Action Process (CCAP). On 2024-12-11, the issue was concluded as potentially critical and the Critical Concern Management Team (CCMT) initiated a technical investigation to conclude customer symptom, risk assessment, testing, root cause etc. On 2024-12-13 the technical investigation was complete, the CCMT team took the decision to start the preparation of a recall as it was judged as an increased risk towards motor vehicle safety.

Description of Remedy :

Description of Remedy Program :	To remedy concerned vehicles, Polestar will replace the driver side inner far-side airbag. If an out-of-pocket expense has been paid for prior to this repair being performed, prior to receiving this letter, customers may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre- notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
