Description of the Safety Risk: A missing airbag warning label can lead to a lack of customer awareness of

the airbag system and its deployment in the event of a crash; and can potentially hinder the customer's understanding of the airbag system

functionality, increasing the risk of injury.

Description of the Cause: Due to a damaged network cable, an error proofing station in the Ford

assembly plant did not identify that certain vehicles required installation of an airbag dashboard warning label.

Chronology:

On April 10, 2025, an issue pertaining to missing dashboard airbag warning labels was brought to Ford's Critical Concern Review Group (CCRG) for review. This issue was discovered when the Customer Acceptance Line (CAL) Right Hand Front relief inspector at Dearborn Truck Plant (DTP) informed the team leader and process coach that airbag hang tags were missing from Model Year (MY) 2025 F150 vehicles.

Further investigation determined that, on April 5, 2025, a damaged network cable caused a configuration update to fail at the error proofing station. This error proofing station indicates whether a vehicle requires a dashboard airbag warning label. Due to this failed update, certain vehicles that required a dashboard airbag warning label were built without the label.

Ford's CCRG reviewed the FMVSS 208 requirements and determined that the affected vehicles do not comply with section 4.5.1(e) Labeling and Owners Guide Information of the regulation.

On April 16, 2025, Ford's Field Review Committee reviewed the concern and approved a field action.

Ford is not aware of any reports of accident or injury related to this condition.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program : Ford will mail owners the dashboard airbag warning label. Dealers will

inspect unsold vehicles and install the required label, as necessary.

Ford provided the general reimbursement plan for the cost of remedies paid for by vehicle owners prior to notification of a safety recall in May 2023. Owners who have paid to have these repairs completed at their own expense may be eligible for reimbursement, in accordance with the recall

reimbursement plan on file with NHTSA.

How Remedy Component Differs The remedy for this recall is to provide the missing warning label.
