Description of remedy program:

Forest River will provide all parts and labor free of charge to Consumers and Dealers. An authorized Forest River dealer will need to perform the remedy to replace the 48" LP gas hose with a 72" LP gas hose and route it correctly.

How remedy component differs from recalled component:

Affected Component – 48" LP gas hose Replacement Component – 72" LP gas hose

The LP gas hose will now be longer and routed correctly to not come in contact with the furnace.

Identify how/when recall condition was corrected in production:

During the week of July 10, 2025, the manufacturing plant installed a longer LP hose allowing for the appropriate clearance to not be damaged by the furnace.
